Furthermore she was teaching at Bauhaus-University Weimar, University of Applied Sciences Augsburg and at New Jersey Institute of Technology, USA. She was guest critic at GSAPP Columbia University, City College NY, NYIT New York, New York, Universität der Künste Berlin.
