<b>HAWK facts and figures (2024)</b>	HAWK Hildesheim/Holzminden/Goettingen – University of Applied Sciences and Arts, has six faculties at three locations in Lower Saxony, Germany, about 100 kilometres apart from each other. It offers 19 Master and 29 Bachelor programmes for the subjects: design, social work and health, architecture, engineering, conservation (Hildesheim), construction, management, social work (Holzminden), resource management, engineering and health (Goettingen). The total number of students is about 6.500. Research priorities focus on three areas: laser and plasma technology, sustainable production and use of biogenic raw materials, social / economic processes of integrated urban and regional development.

<b>Language requirements</b>	
<p>Basically, courses at HAWK are taught in German language (B1 level recommended), but the different faculties offer some courses in English and/or tutoring in English is possible (B1 level required).</p> <p>The study programs <b>BA Architecture</b>, <b>BA Design</b>, <b>MA Design</b>, <b>BA Social Work</b> and <b>BA Early Childhood Education and Care</b> even offer a <b>30 ECTS program in English</b>.</p>

## Housing

<b>Information on housing procedure</b>	Exchange students apply for housing service on the application form. The International Office helps finding accommodation at all three locations of HAWK.
<b>Deadline for housing applications</b>	Winter semester: 15.06. Summer semester: 15.11.
<b>Type of student housing available</b>	Single room, single apartment, in dormitories or shared flats
<b>Is accommodation guaranteed for Erasmus+ students?</b>	Yes, every Erasmus+ student receives one offer for a room or an apartment (choice of type not guaranteed).
<b>What is the average cost of accommodation per month?</b>	Rental fees are between € 300 and € 450 per month, including utilities (water, heating, electricity) Normally, a security deposit of one month's rent is due at the beginning of the rental period.

## Useful information for incoming students

<b>Cost of living</b>	A minimum of approx. € 940 per month is necessary.
<b>Orientation weeks</b>	At the beginning of each semester, an orientation week is offered for all international (exchange and degree) students. Incoming students learn all about registration procedures and any other information needed for the semester. The orientation program includes visiting tours etc. at the study location and nearby. It is also a good way to meet other international students. Students are guided by International Office staff and senior tutors ("Say HI"- buddy program).
<b>Fees payable to HAWK (2024)</b>	There are no tuition fees in public universities in Germany. However, a semester fee has to be paid, which includes <b>free public transport in Lower Saxony</b> and cheaper meals at the cafeteria with the student card for the whole semester. The semester fee varies at the different locations: Hildesheim: € 290 approx. (exchange students) € 360 approx. (degree students) Holzminden: € 180 approx. (exchange students) € 260 approx. (degree students) Goettingen: € 260 approx. (exchange students) € 340 approx. (degree students). After payment, students will receive all documents needed for their stay at the university, including the student card.
