HAWK facts and figures (2026)	HAWK Hildesheim/Holzminden/Goettingen – University of Applied Sciences and Arts, has seven faculties at three locations in Lower Saxony, Germany, about 100 kilometres apart from each other. It offers 19 Master and 29 Bachelor programmes for the subjects: design, social work and health, architecture, engineering, conservation (Hildesheim), construction, management, social work (Holzminden), resource management, engineering and health (Goettingen). The total number of students is about 6.500. HAWK has four main research focus areas: laser and plasma technology; regional development, education and participation; green engineering and ecosystems; and health, technology, and digitalisation.

Housing

Information on housing procedure	The International Office helps students with finding accommodation at all three locations of HAWK.
Deadline for housing applications (for exchange students coming to Hildesheim)	Winter semester: 15.06. Summer semester: 15.11.
Type of student housing available (Hildesheim)	Single room, single apartment, in dormitories or shared flats
Is accommodation guaranteed for ERASMUS+ students?	While accommodation cannot be guaranteed, exchange students coming to Hildesheim will receive a room offer. Students coming to Holzminden or Göttingen will receive support in finding accommodation.
What is the average cost of accommodation per month?	Rental fees are between € 350 and € 500 per month, including utilities (water, heating, electricity). Normally, a security deposit of one month's rent is due at the beginning of the rental period.

Useful information for incoming students

Cost of living	A minimum of approx. € 1.000 per month is necessary.												
Orientation weeks	At the beginning of each semester, an orientation week is offered for all international (exchange and degree) students at the Hildesheim campus. Incoming students learn all about registration procedures and any other information needed for the semester. The orientation programme includes visiting tours etc. at the study location and nearby. It is also a good way to meet other international students. Students are guided by International Office staff and senior tutors ("Say HI"- buddy programme).												
Fees at HAWK (2026)	<p>There are no tuition fees in public universities in Germany.
